January 19, 2011

WELCOME Co-President Beth Seibert called the meeting to order at 7:20 pm. with approximately 13 people in attendance.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT Co-President Beth Seibert thanked Laurie Blackburn for demonstrating some of the technology funded by allocations from Tiger PAWS.

SECRETARY'S REPORT **A motion to approve the October 20, 2010 meeting minutes was made by Bonnie Disbrow and seconded by Tom Barto. The motion was approved.**

TREASURER'S REPORT The fund balance as of 1/19/11 is \$162,682.36. An Audit Review is being completed and will be available for review shortly. Karie Bell is taking a leave of absence from the position of Treasurer. Co-President Pam Marines has taken over the duties of Treasurer.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Principal Dave Claypool advised that the 8th grade Orientation Evening on February 2nd will provide an opportunity to create an atmosphere of what the incoming students can expect at Wheaton Warrenville South. Having Tiger Merchandise on sale contributes to the atmosphere.
- The Finals week recently completed had a maximum of two finals per day with significant study time provided, a change from the previous maximum of three finals per day. Feedback is being pursued on the new approach.
- A presentation will be made to the faculty on adjusting the daily schedule to include 23 minutes each day for studying, making up work, etc. This type of schedule currently is in place at Wheaton North.
