One giant party is executed twice during back to back weekends in the spring. A collaboration between Wheaton North and Wheaton Warrenville South parents and the Wheaton Park District, which began 17 years ago, the events have grown to include the support of hundreds of volunteers and individuals, businesses, and community donors.

Date: Wheaton North Party, Saturday, April 28th, 11 pm-3 am
Wheaton Warrenville South Party, Saturday, May 5th, 11pm -3 am

Place: Wheaton Community Center, 1777 S. Blanchard. This year's theme is "At the Movies" featuring rooms decorated with different movie themes.

For: All juniors and senior are invited. Students do not need to attend their school's prom to go to Post Prom.

Cost: Tickets are \$15 in advance and \$20 at the door. No additional money is needed once admitted.

Nearly 1,400 students attend this party during the two weekends. They enjoy creative decorations, continuous activities and games, terrific food, a senior memory room, 'round the clock cash prizes, and a Grand Prize drawing at 3 AM of \$1,000. Activities include inflatable games such as a Bungee Run and Bouncy Boxing; as well as caricature artists and karaoke provided by Record-A-Hit vendor. Students also enjoy playing bingo and button making while hanging out with their friends during the party.

PTA members from District 200 and the community at large are invited to preview the spectacular themed decorations and fun activities at the Community Center from 7-9 PM on both April 28 and May 5.
