For many incoming freshmen, the first day of high school can be an intimidating experience. Junior Parent Letter

Junior year in high school is an important one as students begin making post-secondary plans. In the past, a letter has been mailed home to the parents of all juniors in August regarding college testing, test preparation courses, and other important dates for juniors. This year to save on mailing costs, the letter will be posted on our website—which also makes for easy reference. A PACE message will be sent home in the fall when the dates indicated in the letter are finalized and the letter is ready for viewing. Please refer to this letter throughout your student's junior year. Anyone who does not have internet access may contact the Counseling Center at 630.784.7206 and a copy of the letter will be mailed to you.

PSAT Sign-Up

Attention Juniors:

Those who are interested in signing up for the PSAT must see Cyndy Englehart in the treasurer's office the week of Sept 7th – 11th to sign up for a cost of \$20. The following week Sept 14th – 18th a \$5 late fee will be added to the cost of the test. After Sept 18th at 3pm PSAT registration will be closed to all students and we will not allow anyone to sign up to take the exam. The PSAT has been developed to prepare students for the SAT that students may take later during their junior year for college admissions. The PSAT also serves as a National Merit State Qualifying Exam, so students that are in advanced classes and rank in the top 5% of their class are especially encouraged to sign up. The test will be held this year in the morning of October 17th at Wheaton North. Please contact Ms. McCabe in the Counseling Center with any questions.

ATTENTION: CLASS OF 2010

Do you believe your student is a senior? Where has the time gone! Hopefully your summer plans include visiting some college campuses to gain a perspective of college life. It is important for students to follow directions when completing an application. To help with this process, the counselors will visit senior English classes during the first week of September. It is the suggestion of the Counseling Center staff to send applications AFTER this informative session. Throughout the month of September each student will meet individually with their counselor and address any specific issues.

Fall ACT and SAT testing for Juniors

The first testing dates for the ACT and SAT have registration dates that begin this summer. More testing information will be included in the Junior letter that should arrive home mid August. Make note of these dates..

ACT Test Date: September 12, 2009 : Registration Deadline is: August 7.

ACT Test Date: October 24, 2009 : Registration Deadline is: September 18.

SAT Test Date: October 10, 2009 : Registration Deadline is: September 9.

Bringing Young Hearts for Life to Our School October 2009

Sadly, we have all heard stories and read articles about teens, seemingly in peak athletic condition, who suddenly and shockingly have died during sports activities.



The leading cause of sudden cardiac death in young adults is triggered by a hidden heart defect that is both detectable and treatable. Yet most pre-participation sports physicals do not include a quick, noninvasive test that can signal the presence of a serious heart condition.

The tragedy of these deaths for families and our communities is amplified when we realize how needless and preventable they are: one-third of these deaths may have been prevented through a simple, inexpensive heart screening. Many of these life threatening heart conditions in young adults can be detected with an electrocardiogram (EKG).

Midwest Heart Community Foundation is working to increase awareness of sudden cardiac death in young adults. Young Hearts for Life™ Cardiac Screening Program was created to identify high school students at risk for sudden cardiac death. To date, Midwest Heart Community Foundation has screened over 32,000 students in collaboration with schools, parents and area hospitals. The free screening involves a simple 3 minute EKG, (a painless, non-invasive test that provides information about heart rate and rhythm), administered by qualified medical volunteers at area high schools during the regular academic year.

Wheaton Warrenville South High School, welcomes Midwest Heart Community Foundation and Central DuPage Hospital, in offering all of our high school students a free EKG screening as part of this unprecedented program to identify teenagers at risk of sudden cardiac death. Young Hearts for Life™ Cardiac Screening program is scheduled at our school on **Thursday, October 29 and Friday, October 30th, 2009.**

Student registration will be required. Registration forms and more information will be available to families in the near future. For more information and answers to frequently asked questions, please visit www.mhcfoundation.org or call Midwest Heart Community Foundation at 630-310-2136.

In the spirit of keeping you well informed, the physicians associated with Midwest Heart and the Young Hearts for Life program are neither agents nor employees of Central DuPage Hospital or any of its affiliate organizations. These physicians have selected our facilities as the place where they want to treat and care for their patients.

Current international recommendations are to repeat the EKG every other year through age 25.
