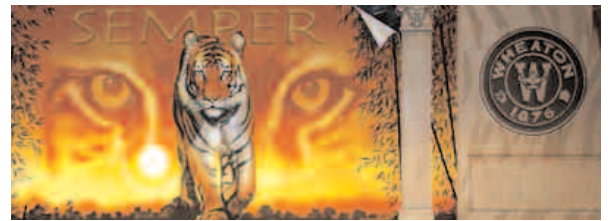

PSAT Sign-Up

Attention Juniors:

Those who are interested in signing up for the PSAT must see Cyndy Englehart in the treasurer's office the week of Sept 8th – 12th to sign up for a cost of \$20. The following week Sept 15th – 19th a \$5 late fee will be added to the cost of the test. After Sept 19th at 3pm PSAT registration will be closed to all students and we will not allow anyone to sign up to take the exam. The PSAT has been developed to prepare students for the SAT that students may take later during their junior year for college admissions. The PSAT also serves as a National Merit State Qualifying Exam, so students that are in advanced classes and rank in the top 5% of their class are especially encouraged to sign up. The test will be held this year in the morning of October 18th at Wheaton Warrenville South. Please contact Ms. McCabe in the Counseling Center with any questions.

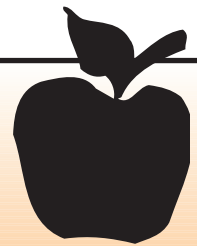
Stock up for Summer

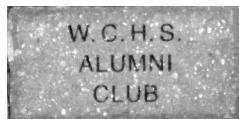
