April 20, 2011



**WELCOME** Co-President Pam Marines called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. with approximately 24 people in attendance.

**Scholarship** - Scholarship recipients Danielle Barto, Anna Bouck, Colin Fedor, Lauren Keltner, Andrew Horton and Felicia Owens were recognized for their efforts. Each read the essay submitted to the Scholarship Committee and was presented with a \$500 award. Thank you to the Scholarship Committee Liz Hunka, Bonnie Adomschick, Paula Serfling, Ann Mather, Eva Peerson, Jill Jakubowski and Chairman Sue Christensen.

**PRESIDENT'S REPORT** - Thank you to all Committee Chairmen and their committees for their hard work throughout this school year.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT** - The March 16, 2011 meeting minutes were reviewed.

**TREASURER'S REPORT** - The fund balance as of 4/20/11 is \$140,978.32.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS

**Beautification** - Bobbie Mignin reported that three companies provided proposals to design the area near the front entrance of school. The company selected provided the most economical proposal. ## **Final Transcript Release Forms**

**Seniors** – As you learn of your acceptances into college, it is important to note that colleges require verification that a student has graduated from high school. This is accomplished by sending in a Final Transcript. **Students must send a Final Transcript only to the college they have decided to attend.**

All Seniors should stop by the Counseling Center to complete a yellow Final Transcript Form as soon as they have chosen a school to attend in the fall.

**Transcripts are NOT sent automatically.**

Students who do not complete this process may have their college registration process delayed.

All Final Transcript requests will be held and mailed after second semester grades have been posted in June 2011. Questions? Please see your Counselor.

It is called the "Snapshot Echo" because it is similar to taking a quick picture of the heart. Measurements are listed on the patients physical form. No official cardiology reports are generated.

**CARDIAC LIFE SCREEN**

Cardiac Life Screen is an echocardiogram and an EKG screening tailored for athletes. It is similar to a pediatric echocardiogram and over 30 measurements of heart walls and valves are recorded. It is intended to screen for many cardiac abnormalities that lead to sudden cardiac arrest or death. A cardiologist reviews and interprets the screening results, which are mailed to the patients home. Results can be amended to the students ongoing medical record either at home or at the student's family doctor's office.
